HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR CHILD?

- Play number games, concentrating on numbers to 10 and 20 and talk about one more/one less than a number to 20

HOMEWORK: 10-15 minutes of daily reading, including tricky words and letter sounds that were sent home from the workshops. Use the Phase 2 & 3 letter cards sent home with your child to make words – alien and real and to practise correct formation of cursive letters using the guide that will be sent home.
